This project was delivered through the YORbuild framework. Hobson & Porter worked around the facility's events programme to keep it open and income maintained throughout the project. Refurbishment of the existing projector room and associated areas, with demolition of walls and floors to allow a new staircase to be installed, was being conducted while a full refurbishment of the central heating and boilers took place in the Grade II listed building. Renovation of the first floor, creating a new bar area, included replacing items such as windows and fire places.

The redevelopment has improved disabled access and security throughout the building, added a spacious open plan foyer, additional office space, meeting room facilities for external hire and an intimate second cinema screen dedicated to specialist film (foreign language, documentary and shorts) and live broadcasts. The aim of the work was to enhance the customer experience, make the venue more accessible and to ensure its long term sustainability.

During the project Hobson & Porter gave students from Bishop Burton College the opportunity to experience one of its live sites. As well as being able to see Hobson & Porter's construction staff at work, students and tutors were given information regarding the history of Pocklington Arts Centre, a tour of the site and an explanation of the work being undertaken.
