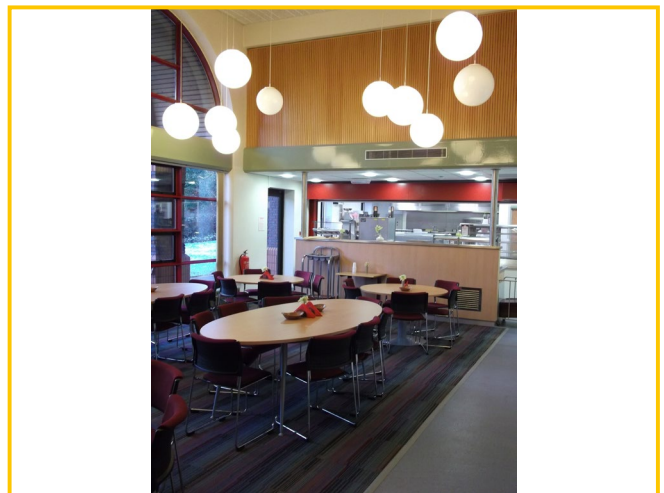
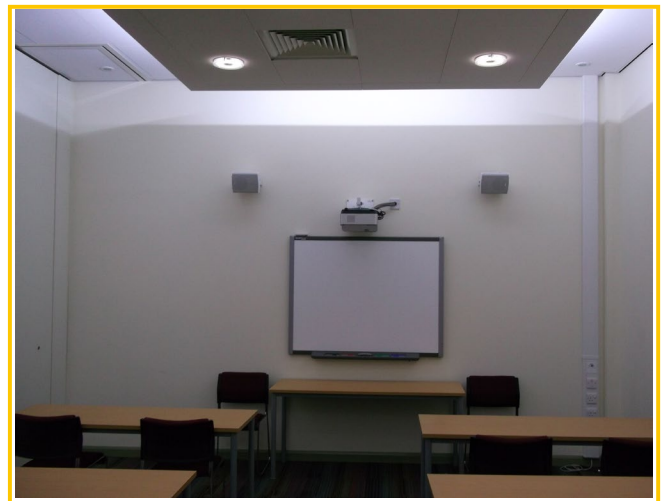

The 1.9 hectare site occupied by the Operational Headquarters of the Humberside Fire and Rescue Service. The main office block, situated centrally within the site required alterations to create new offices and a meeting room to suit the current needs of the Service.

The works comprised the internal alterations of the Humberside Fire & Rescue Headquarters administration areas, including the remodelling of the former archives store to create new office accommodation, with an archive store located above on a mezzanine floor. Also, remodelling of the ground floor toilet and first floor office, installation of a sliding glazed screen within the entrance lobby, and remodelling of the existing dining room to form meeting rooms.

The refurbishment included blocking up of openings with reference to door and windows and the creation of new, installation of mechanical and electrical services and mezzanine floor works, together with associated decorations, floor, wall and ceiling finishes to create a fresh, new look to the area.



EMPLOYMENT AND SKILLS
